

PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Buyer agrees to the following:

1. Under no circumstances will this cat/kitten be sold, leased or given away to any pet shop.
2. This cat/kitten will be kept indoors and not allowed to roam freely outside.
3. This cat/kitten is purchased as a **Pet ____ Show ____**.
4. Buyer agrees to spay/neuter this cat at 6-8 months.
5. Seller will provide pedigree and registration papers upon receiving veterinarian's certificate of spay/neuter.
6. All vaccinations will be current at time of purchase and Buyer will be expected to provide further vaccinations.
7. This kitten/cat **will not** be declawed.
8. This kitten/cat is being fed: Royal Canin Baby Cat / Kitten with an occasional treat of canned.
9. The Buyer agrees to keep the kitten/cat in a clean and pleasant environment, uncaged, and with proper nutrition, health care, and companionship. If the kitten/cat is found to be neglected, the Seller shall have the right to reclaim the animal at no cost to Seller. Neglect shall include being left alone for periods in excess of 72 hours, poor diet, poor health (that is not currently being treated), and otherwise poor condition.
10. If at some point the Buyer no longer desires, or is not able to keep the kitten/cat, the Buyer shall first notify Seller, who shall have first right to take the kitten/cat back at no cost to Seller. If Seller is unable to take the kitten/cat, Buyer and Seller will work together to find a new home for the kitten/cat. Any placement of this kitten/cat must be in a good home, as a pet, and may only be made after the kitten/cat has been altered.

It doesn't matter what age your cat may be, contact Seller before taking it to a shelter for any reason.

Failure to comply with these conditions will result in the voiding of any and all health guarantees on this cat.

Health Guarantee:

The Seller represents and warrants that the kitten/cat is in good health and free from any known ailments. Within five (5) days of receipt of the kitten/cat, Buyer is recommended to, at their option and sole expense; have the kitten/cat examined by a licensed veterinarian. If, upon examination, a veterinarian finds the kitten/cat to be medically deficient and suffering from an untreatable or life-threatening problem, Seller shall replace the kitten/cat with one of comparable value as soon as one is available. If such veterinarian certifies that the kitten/cat can be cured, the Seller will pay for half of reasonable and necessary vet expenses. Seller has the right to examine all bills and receipts (as well as the complete medical history of kitten/cat), and may require a second opinion if there is a valid concern regarding the diagnosis and/or treatment plan before such payments are made. If the Buyer is requesting replacement under the terms of this contract, the kitten/cat must be returned to the Seller. Before any

such return takes place, Seller will request that the kitten/cat be tested for FeLV and FIP, at the expense of Buyer.

The cat/kitten is guaranteed against congenital defects for one year. Should the cat die within that time as a direct result of a congenital defect, the cat will be replaced only if an appropriate autopsy is performed by a licensed vet and a vet's certificate is provided as a proof of cause of death. A replacement will be made of a cat of comparable quality and value, as available, at the discretion of the breeder.

Other:

- We do not recommend vaccinating this cat/kitten with the FIP vaccine. The FIP vaccine is not safe¹.
- We do not recommend vaccinating for Feline Leukemia (FeLV). As your pet is an indoor pet, it is not required.
- IF FIP or FeLK VACCINE IS GIVEN TO THIS CAT/KITTEN, THE ENTIRE HEALTH GUARANTEE BECOMES NULL AND VOID.

This contract is legally binding to all parties involved. It applies to the Buyer and Seller in this transaction and is non-transferable to other parties. Any legal fees incurred in upholding the provisions of this contract will be paid by Buyer. All disputes regarding the contract are to be litigated in the SELLER'S state and based upon the SELLER'S home state's laws. The Buyer gives their vet permission to disclose medical records if requested by Seller or Seller's representative.
